Structural traumatic dissociation





Model of normal integration



Atrocities, however, refuse to be buried. »



«complex», trauma repetitive, escape or protection are not possible =
complex PTSD / developmental trauma




captivity

...is the central life problem of a (complex-) traumatized person.




Contextualization deficit ... is the most relevant basic pathomechanism in PTSD







Fig. 1 TEP moyenne (coronale, sagittale et axiale) de la distribution des récepteurs opioïdes chez les sujets normaux, superposée sur une IRM. Notez la richesse du gyrus cingulaire antérieur (cercle bleu), l'insula (cercle rouge) et la substance grise péréiaqueducale (cercle jaune) en récepteurs opioïdes. En revanche, notez la pauvreté du cortex sensorimoteur primaire (cercle vert) en récepteurs opioïdes




Psilocybin-induced changes in vmPFC (red) functional connectivity





4 men and 2 women killed; 14 people injured ; the killer committed suicide




The werewolves of our epoch



As long as the vampires keep running away from themselves, they create hell on earth and avoid realizing their true divine nature.



Why does man self-flagellate every time he becomes aware of his self-reflexive consciousness?

1. Expulsion from paradise: the establishment of patriarchy (Book of Genesis)
2. The assimilation of pagan cults with the rise of Christianity (from the 4th century A.D.);
3. the destruction of women's knowledge by the Inquisition and the witch-hunt in the Middle Ages;
4. the “war on drugs” in 1971;
5. humanity's submission to black magic (technology) and deception (virtual reality and artificial intelligence).

Erich Fromm:

*“Human existence and freedom are inseparable from the beginning. Freedom is not to be understood here in its positive sense of '**freedom for something**', but in its negative sense of '**freedom from something**'.*


