From the angle of socio-economic history, sociology, anthropology, and psychodynamics of work, we will address the organization of workplace activities and the resulting social inequalities.

Content and objectives: this course aims at giving an overview of different theories, current debates, and methods in the Social Anthropology related to Gender Studies. We particularly focus on the role of women anthropologists and their contribution to the discipline's institutionalization.

Content and objectives: this course follows a historical presentation of the characteristics of paid work and the sociological and economical perspectives developed to understand the realities of the labour market, in relation to other spheres of society. Particular attention is paid to the gender dimension of paid and unpaid work and the future of work and its challenges (digitalization, precarity, new social and solidarity-based economic models, such as the universal basic income or the revaluation of care work).

BA Seminar: *Sociologie de l'éducation*, with G. Goastellec (56h/semester, 40 students)
Content and objectives: this seminar gives students the opportunity to discover the principles of doing research in the sociology of education through the study of various subjects. In 2021, the students investigated the digital disruption in higher education during the Covid-pandemic. They were conducting qualitative research on sanitary and pedagogical measures, and the way they affected the learning processes and strategies of students at the University of Lausanne.
BA Course: *Sociologie générale*, with G. Goastellec (56h/year, 600-700 students)
Content and objectives: this course introduces the general perspectives of sociology as a discipline by presenting a selection of topics (ie. migration, work, education, deviance) and of theoretical approaches related to them.
